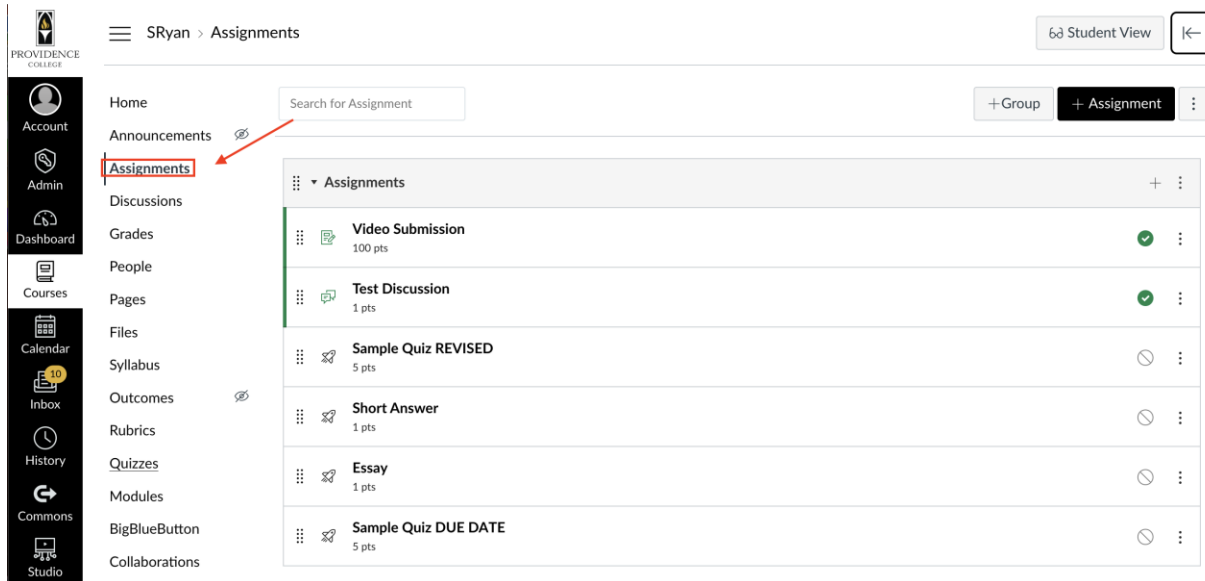


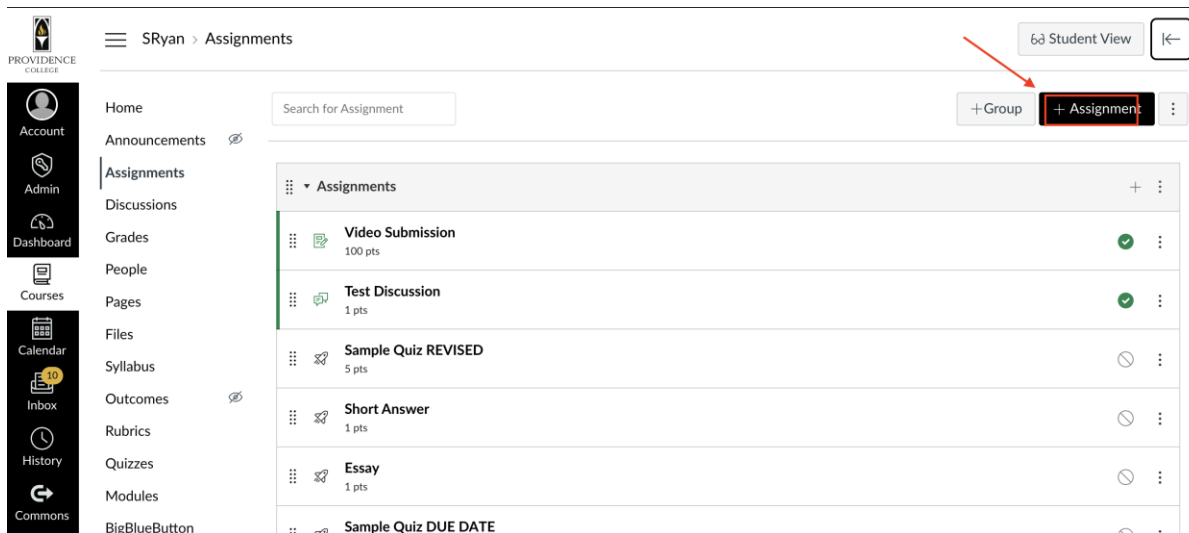
## Adding the LinkedIn Learning LTI in Canvas

Follow the steps below to add a LinkedIn Learning lesson to your course site so that it will launch from Canvas.

1. Once logged into Canvas, open the course you wish to add the LinkedIn Learning lesson, and click the **Assignments** tab.



2. Click the **+ Assignment** button.



3. Name assignment and then set **Points** to 100.

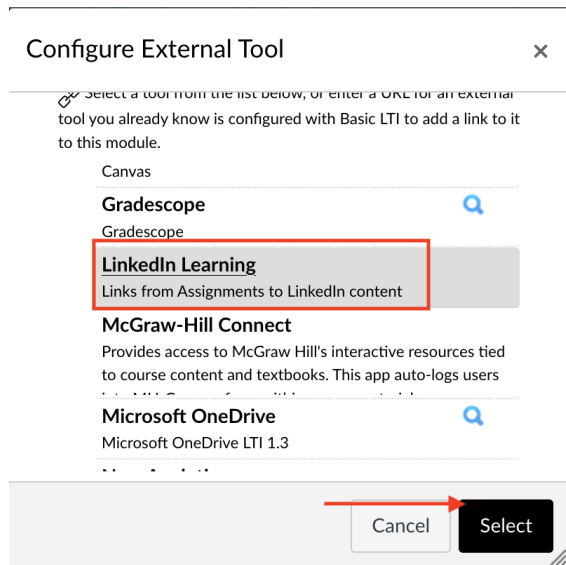

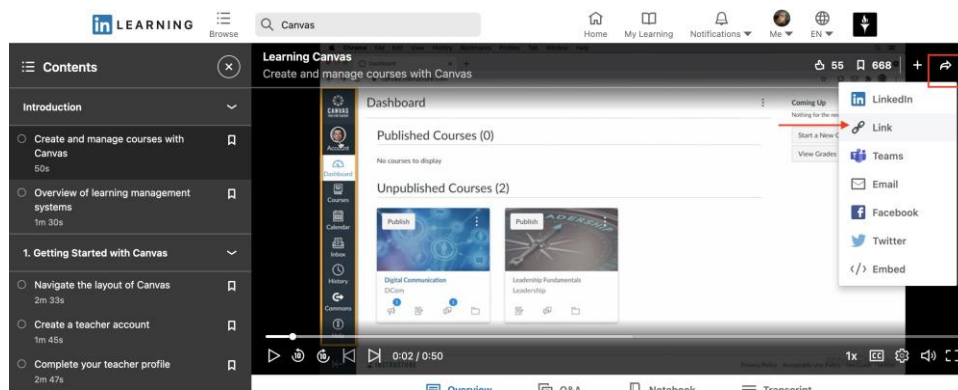
